

## Job trainees keen as mustard

NOVA Employment's Focus on Ability in Macarthur campaign is entering its final weeks but there's still time for employers to get on board.

The campaign has seen Nova Employment and the Advertiser join forces to encourage employers in Macarthur find jobs for 100 people with a disability.

Among the success stories are trainees who are now working for local businesses such as Phoenix Health Club, Combined Property and Maintenance Services and Sizzlers.

The campaign, which was launched in May, has secured jobs for almost 50 people with a disability.

Nova Employment chief executive Martin Wren said employers should look beyond labels and see how people with disabilities had the necessary skills and could contribute as much as an able-bodied employee.
